Project: Roy Hill Operations Centre

Project Profile: The Roy Hill Corporate Headquarters and Remote Operations Centre is a 6,900sqm 3 storey building with a basement. It provides offices for 300 Roy Hill project personnel and a mining operations control room for 30 staff within the Perth Airport Precinct.

The central component of the ROC is the control room, which houses the Demand Chain team who are responsible for the operational planning, scheduling and execution of production activities across all areas of operations. The key focus for the Demand Chain team is data.

The gathering, validating and reporting of real time and near real time operational data that is used to support and drive key operational decision making delivers optimisation of production throughput, quality and reliability across the entire business.

Perkins Builders engaged Nilsen Pty Ltd for the supply, installation, testing and commissioning of the electrical services including LV power supply system, transformers, generators, UPS, underfloor busbar system, communications systems, lighting control systems, security systems and emergency monitoring systems.

Nilsen engaged 25 employees on this project at its peak.

This 18 month project was completed in November 2013.
