Project: Liverpool Hospital Re-Development: Milestones 3 & 4

Project Profile: Nilsen was contracted by Lend Lease to carry out the design and construction of the electrical refurbishment for the Clinical Services and Cancer Centre buildings at Liverpool Hospital in Sydney's South West. The Cancer Centre and the Clinical Services buildings are amongst the complex redevelopment featuring 855 beds, 23 operating rooms, 60 intensive care beds, a major new ambulatory care centre, additional parking, two rooftop helipads and new education facilities. It also features an elevated road and separate pedestrian bridge over the railway, linking the eastern and western campuses.

Overall construction commenced in 2007 with Nilsen initiating the intricate refurbishment of the Cancer and Clinical Services Buildings in May 2011. The Hospital will be the largest tertiary facility in NSW when completed.

The refurbishment includes the re-using of existing infrastructure where possible with new outlets, switches, RCD Field units, lighting, communications and Nurse Call services. The project will also boast 2 state-of-the-art laser therapy 'bunkers'.
