Project: Western Australia Police Forensic Building

Project Profile: This project is one of the key components to the West Australian Police Services complex in Midland, which coordinates and facilitates the state of West Australia.

These facilities will cater for up to 1,000 operatives when fully commissioned and will house equipment that is at the cutting edge of police forensic science. The site incorporates a Helicopter Landing Pad along side ample Car parking facilities. The building itself incorporates office areas, Finger Printing analysis departments, Photographic Imaging department and a Ballistics department complete with it's own firing range, along with numerous specialised laboratories.

BGC Construction engaged Nilsen Pty Ltd together with Wood & Grieve Engineers for the design, installation and commissioning of the Total Electrical, Fire Detection, EWIS, PA, MATV, Security, CCTV and Communication systems.

The Car Park required a major network of pits, conduits and cable routing, to accommodate the extensive security and CCTV system that is required for premises of this nature. The Car Park lighting was designed to give excellent lighting levels whilst accommodating for the aviation requirements for the Helicopter Landing Pad.
